rumi at the age of thirty seven meets shams tabrizi the sun of tabriz a weird figure wrapped in coarse black felt who flits across the stage for a moment and disappears tragically enough shams has variously been described as being extremely ugly a most disgusting cynic and exceedingly aggressive with a domineering manner jalaluddin who until then had no interest or liking for poetry found in the stranger that perfect image of the divine beloved which he had long been seeking he took him away to his house and for a year or two they remained inseparable rumi's pupils resented their teacher's preoccupation with the eccentric stranger and vilified and intrigued against him until shams fled to damascus rumi sent his son to bring him back but the tongues of his jealous traducers soon wagged again and in 1247 the man of mystery vanished without leaving a trace behind nicholson has selected his favourites from rumi's love poems and translated them into english along with the original persian

shams the sun of love that burned rumi s heart shams the real treasure hunter the exchanger of love shams the martyr of love who sacrificed his head to rumi one day in 2002 i went to konya to visit rumi i was just about to enter the door of the shrine when an old man with a white beard came in front of me and rejected my entry into the shrine and said no don t you do this you should first go and visit shams and then come back here i went back learned where the shrine of shams of tabriz was and went there i entered the mosque that i hadn t visited before bashfully i saw the tomb of shams in front of me i approached and said my prayer the mosque official started to recite the iqama for the obligatory afternoon prayer the community formed a line i was touched all of a sudden my inner heart said oh the sultan of lovers what have you turned rumi into i wish you were here today so that we could perform the prayer together shoulder to shoulder at that moment someone sharp eyed from the front rows called out to me inviting me with a fine strong voice saying then come here i went next to him and stood on his left side my knees were trembling with excitement he leaned his shoulder on mine and we started the prayer oh my god his shoulder was like a fire this fire burned my body during the prayer in the last unit of the prayer i said to myself my god let me hug him after the prayer then take my life when i turned to him after completing the prayer i could not see him i asked the man next to me where is he he answered he stood up quickly and disappeared i almost fainted and could not pull myself together for a while when i gathered myself everyone had left and the mosque was empty i stood up and went back to rumi s shrine to complete my visit in peace after my visit i became happy when i realized how much rumi is known and loved in our country and abroad after that day i promised myself to introduce shams of tabriz who has contributed to rumi becoming who he is as much as i can and in 2003 i published the first edition of this book i am very happy that many books about shams have been published today and that shams has gotten the attention he deserves i am proud to be one of the people to start this research

poems and commentary that open the door for a new generation to experience the ecstatic and embodied spiritual truths contained in rumi s poetry reveals how the four practices of eating lightly breathing deeply moving freely and gazing intently can invoke the divinity within us all explains how these practices dissolve the self s need for identity so that we may experience a state of transcendent ecstasy and union with the divine takes rumi s path to finding god from theoretical to embodied practices the great thirteenth century sufi mystic and poet jalaluddin rumi began his life as an orthodox islamic believer but felt that to fully experience complete union with the divine he must abandon institutionalized religion and its prescribed forms of worship surrendering his will to his overriding urge for a much more immediate intuitive and compelling union with the divine he found that by manipulating certain behavioral aspects of his physiology eating lightly breathing deeply moving freely and gazing raptly he was capable of loosening the rigid confines of the self thereby overriding its limitations and achieving a transcendent merging with his own divinity his message is simple if you wish to affect the spirit you must first make changes in the way your body responds to the world through clearly written commentary interspersed with rumi s beautiful poems this book details these four practices in a very precise way as such it is a sweet and open invitation to follow the examples set forth in order to embark upon one s own path of inner illumination the freshness of rumi s poetry dissolves the 700 years that separate his life from our own time making his message as pertinent today as when he walked the streets of konya anatolia present day turkey reciting his inspiring verse this book allows us through rumi s gentle guidance to touch the face of god that resides deep within us all

to whom he was passionately attached beginning around 1258 the series of stories although unfinished is regarded by persians as the persian koran and as one of the two most important works of persian literature just as beautiful is rumi s the divan of shams i tabriz a work written expressly for his mentor shams and titled to indicate that shams is the author as if the two men had become one person rumi believed shams to be perfect in the image of god thus he believed that when he loved shams he was loving god in body and soul not even rumi knew exactly how to describe his relationship with shams even friend and beloved are wrong words for this he said the tone of the divan is uplifting and rumi manages to mix mysticism and the deeply spiritual with an eroticism that approaches the sublime my mouth tastes sweet with your name in it for a world more accustomed to reading praises of the older man for the younger shakespeare s sonnets poems in the greek anthology etc the divan provides a moving account of love from a younger man to an older i turn my face to you and into eternity we have been in love that long rumi s idea of paradise is to be with shams there is a grainy taste i prefer to every idea of heaven human friendship at his best rumi expresses love for another man more profoundly and more poetically than any other writer except perhaps shakespeare or hafiz i see my beauty in you rumi says in another ghazal for shams for seven centuries readers have discovered their own capacity for beauty in the words of rumi
