translator names not noted above mary l booth and orlando w wight originally published between 1909 and 1917 under the name harvard classics this stupendous 51 volume set a collection of the greatest writings from literature philosophy history and mythology was assembled by american academic charles william eliot 1834 1926 harvard university s longest serving president also known as dr eliot s five foot shelf it represented eliot s belief that a basic liberal education could be gleaned by reading from an anthology of works that could fit on five feet of bookshelf volume xlvi features three collections of the writings of french polymath blaise pascal 1623 1662 thoughts considered a great classic of religious writings in which the former child prodigy mounts a sophisticated defense of his catholic faith letters to his friends and family as well as to the swedish queen christina and minor works including prayer to ask of god the proper use of sickness discourses on the condition of the great the art of persuasion and more

transcribed and annotated by gordon introduces readers to an unmarried woman who worked worshiped and wrote about her experience living in moravian religious communities at the time of the american revolution and early republic penry a welsh immigrant and a convert to the moravian faith was well connected in both the international moravian community and the state of pennsylvania she counted among her acquaintances elizabeth sandwith drinker and hannah callender sansom two american women whose writings have also been preserved in addition to members of some of the most prominent families in philadelphia such as the shippens the franklins and the rushes this collection brings together more than seventy of penry s letters few of which have been previously published gordon s introduction provides a useful context for understanding the letters and the unique woman who wrote them this collection of penry s letters broadens perspectives on early america and the eighteenth century moravian church by providing a sustained look at the spiritual and social life of a single woman at a time when singleness was extraordinarily rare it also makes an important contribution to the recovery of women s voices in early america amplifying views on politics religion and social networks from a time when few women s perspectives on these subjects have been preserved

the writing of letters often evokes associations of a single author and a single addressee who share in the exchange of intimate thoughts across distances of space and time this model underwrites such iconic notions as the letter representing an image of the soul of the author or constituting one half of a dialogue however justified this conception of letter writing may be in particular instances it tends to marginalize a range of issues that were central to epistolary communication in the ancient world and have yet to receive sustained and systematic investigation in particular it overlooks the fact that letters frequently presuppose and were designed to reinforce communities or indeed to constitute them in the first place this volume explores the interrelation of letters and communities in the ancient world examining how epistolary communication aided in the construction and cultivation of group identities and communities whether social political religious ethnic or philosophical a theoretically informed introduction establishes the interface of epistolary discourse and group formation as a vital but hitherto neglected area of research and is followed by thirteen case studies offering multi disciplinary perspectives from four key cultural configurations greece rome judaism and christianity the first part opens the volume with two chapters on the theory and practice of epistolary communication that focus on ancient epistolary theory and the unavoidable presence of a letter carrier who introduces a communal aspect into any correspondence while the second comprises five chapters that explore configurations of power and epistolary communication in the greek and roman worlds from the archaic period to the end of the hellenistic age five chapters on letters and communities in ancient judaism and early christianity follow in the third part before the volume concludes with an envoi examining the trans historical or indeed timeless philosophical community seneca the younger construes in his letters to lucilius

david kellogg lewis 1941 2001 was one of the most influential philosophers of the twentieth century he made significant contributions to almost every area of analytic philosophy including metaphysics philosophy of language philosophy of mind and philosophy of science and set the agenda for various debates in these areas which carry on to this day in several respects he remains a contemporary figure yet enough time has now passed for historians of philosophy to begin to study his place in twentieth century thought his philosophy was constructed and refined not just through his published writing but also crucially through his life long correspondence with fellow philosophers including leading figures such as d m armstrong saul kripke w v quine j j c smart and peter van inwagen his letters formed the undercurrent of his published work and became the medium through which he proposed many of his well known theories and discussed a range of philosophical topics in depth a selection of his vast correspondence over a 40 year period is presented here across two volumes as metaphysics is arguably where lewis made his greatest contribution this forms the focus of volume 1 arranged under the broad areas of causation modality and ontology the letters offer an organic story of the origins development breadth and depth of his metaphysics in its historical context as well as a glimpse into the influence of his many interlocutors this volume will be an indispensable resource for contemporary metaphysics and for those interested in the lewisian perspective

the death of ernest hemingway in 1961 ended one of the most original and influential careers in american literature his works have been translated into every major language and the nobel prize awarded to him in 1954 recognized his impact on contemporary writing while many people are familiar with the public image of hemingway and the legendary accounts of his life few knew him as an intimate with this collection of letters presented for the first time as a scribner classic a new hemingway emerges ranging from 1917 to 1961 this generous selection of nearly six hundred letters is in effect both a self portrait and an autobiography in his own words hemingway candidly reveals himself to a wide variety of people family friends enemies editors translators and almost all the prominent writers of his day in so doing he proves to be one of the most entertaining letter writers of all time carlos baker has chosen letters that not only represent major turning points in hemingway's career but also exhibit character wit and the writer's typical enthusiasm for hunting fishing drinking and eating a few are ingratiating some downright truculent others present his views on writing and reading criticize books by friend or foe and discuss women soldiers politicians and prizefighters perhaps more than anything these letters show hemingway's irrepressible humor given far freer rein in his correspondence than in his books an informal biography in letters the product of forty five years living and writing ernest hemingway selected letters leaves an indelible impression of an extraordinary man ernest hemingway was born in oak park illinois in 1899 at seventeen he left home to join the kansas city star as a reporter then volunteered to serve in the red cross during world war i he was severely wounded at the italian front and was awarded the croce di guerra he moved to paris in 1921 where he devoted himself to writing fiction and where he fell in with the expatriate circle that included gertrude stein f scott fitzgerald ezra pound and ford madox ford his novels include the sun also rises 1926 a farewell to arms 1929 to have and have not 1937 for whom the bell tolls 1940 and the old man and the sea 1952 he was awarded the nobel prize for literature in 1954 he died in ketchum idaho on july 2 1961
