howard smither has written the first definitive work on the history of the oratorio since arnold schering published his geschichte des oratoriums in 1911 this volume is the first of a four volume comprehensive study that offers a new synthesis of what is known to date about the oratorio volume 1 divided into three parts opens with the examination of the medieval renaissance and early baroque antecedents and origins of the oratorio with emphasis on rome and philip neri s congregation of the oratory and with special attention to the earliest works for which the term oratorio seems appropriate the second part recounts the development of the oratorio in italy
