John Muir 2013

scottish naturalist john muir 1838 1914 helped spark the modern environmental movement living for months and even years in the wilderness he experienced a deep communion with the sacred and his contemplations on the natural world are filled with mystical intuitions of god s reality this volume contributes to a strain of spirituality that finds an echo in today s environmental movements

Essential Writings 2003

thoreau henry david thoreau 1817 1862 embodies classic features of the american spirit nonconformity the impulse to seek renewal in nature and the will to stand firm by his convictions famous for his retreat to walden pond and his night in jail described in the duty of civil disobedience he was a profoundly religious man though he remained unaffiliated with any organized religion he might well serve as a patron saint for today s spiritual but not religious seekers thoreau experienced mystical ecstasies in his youth he followed an almost monastic discipline of contemplation he was an early pioneer in the exploration of hinduism and eastern religion which he integrated with his deep immersion in nature and his highly refined social conscience this anthology which focuses specific attention on thoreau s spiritual and prophetic writings draws on his voluminous journals correspondence essays and selection from walden and his other key works
